The War-time Band at Rouen in the days of 1914-18.

The Bandsmaster is now Major Nuttall, of India, who about this time wrote his world-famous Army song, "Sunshine."

On his right is Major Jones (Retired), who spent four years on War Service in France.

Second from the left on the front row is Recruiting-Sergeant T. Read, of Swansea, on his right is a comrade from Barking.

At the extreme right of the front row is Brother Whittington, of Hastings.

Second from the right in the back row is Brother Slade, the fourth on the right is Brother Acum, of Wood Green Citadel, next to him toward the left is a comrade from Abingdon. (The Musician, January 20, 1940)
